

Dear Class of 1963 Reunion Participant:

As the reunion draws near we wanted to provide you with more detailed information about our event. We are delighted with what we have learned further about the setting and facilities offered by the Cheyenne Mountain Resort. The resort offers a variety of on-site recreational facilities which include eighteen tennis courts (six indoor), three heated swimming pools (one indoor), two Jacuzzis, squash and racquetball courts, and a fully equipped fitness center with massage and spa facilities, and mountain bike rentals. Water sports on the 35 acre recreational lake include sailing, paddleboats, and fishing. The Cheyenne Mountain Resort staff and the University Alumni Relations Office have been extremely helpful and plan to continue efforts with us during our reunion.
