**Hospital Medicine is the fastest growing area of focus in internal medicine.** This course, presented by the Rocky Mountain Chapter of the Society of Hospital Medicine and sponsored by the University of Colorado Denver Office of Continuing Medical Education, will address many of the clinical, systems based and institutional challenges faced by today's hospital based health care professionals. To provide course content, national leaders in hospital medicine will join top teachers from the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center. Our attendees will be able to participate in an exchange of ideas using case based presentations to improve their ability to deliver health care to hospitalized patients.

This CME program has been designated to meet the educational needs of hospitalists as well as other physicians and allied health partners caring for patients in hospital settings.

### Objectives:

At the conclusion of the program participants should be able to:

- Initiate appropriate medical therapies for patients with advanced liver disease
- Describe the different modalities of cardiac ischemic evaluation for patients hospitalized with chest pain
- Prevent, recognize and treat contrast induced nephropathy in hospitalized patients
- Describe the role of hospitalists in the management of acute ischemic stroke
- Identify emerging infections in hospitalized patients and choose appropriate therapeutic strategies
- Cite methods for prevention of nosocomial infections and their impact on Medicare reimbursements to hospital systems
- Identify successful acute pain management strategies and cite reasons for inadequate pain control in hospitalized patients
- Describe evidence based patient safety and quality initiatives most beneficial to hospital systems
- Describe a system to improve appropriate venous thromboembolism prophylaxis in hospitalized patients
- Identify a method of improving glycemic control in hospitalized patients
- Manage anticoagulation in the peri-operative period
- Identify patterns of cognitive heuristics to improve clinical decision making
- Describe current and emerging strategies for the management of acute congestive heart failure
- Identify and cite the important literature in hospital medicine for 2008
- Incorporate new clinical guidelines to appropriately management the medical care of peri-operative patients
