

## CU GME HEALTH INSURANCE EXTENSION

Subject to eligibility, exiting residents may purchase an extension of the health insurance on a monthly basis for a maximum of 15 months. **This extension is for the health insurance component only.** It does not include dental, life or disability insurance. (The CU GME Health Benefits Plan is NOT subject to COBRA.)

Plan members and dependents covered under any other group plan, ***or eligible to enroll in such a plan*** may **not** enroll in the extension coverage, unless the alternate plan has an exclusion or limitation that applies to the individual with respect to a pre-existing condition.

This Plan's premium rate is composite, meaning the rate is the same for single or family coverage. You must pay for a full month's coverage, except as stated below.

Weekly premium	<b>\$156.00</b>	<b>\$180.00</b>	Only for month during which termination occurs and only for termination dates from 22 <sup>nd</sup> – end of month.

EBMS will mail insurance extension information and forms to your home address as your exit information is received. The completed forms, along with your check for the first month's coverage made payable to "CU GME Extension" must be returned to EBMS; 13901 East Exposition Avenue; Aurora, CO 80012 **postmarked no later than your last day in the program. LATE PAYMENT CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.**

The plan provisions for the extension coverage are the same as those for active residents. If you enroll in the extension, it is your responsibility to keep track of any changes in plan provisions that may occur, as extension coverage is subject to these changes.
