Thank you for your willingness to precept pediatric residents, medical students, and physician assistant students. You will have a lasting impact on the training of these health care providers. Trainees have identified their preceptor experiences as a very important learning part of their education and training. We hope you will find the experience rewarding and rejuvenating to your career.

Individuals with Clinical Faculty appointments who precept University of Colorado residents and students in their offices are covered by the University of Colorado Self Insurance and Risk Management Trust for any claims of negligent supervision of the resident/student arising from the preceptor relationship. However, the University does not provide malpractice insurance for patient claims alleging medical negligence on the part of the preceptor. Therefore, Clinical Faculty members should maintain their own malpractice coverage for patient care activities.
