

Directions to The University of Colorado Hospital

General Note –

The University of Colorado Hospital (UCH) is located a few miles southeast of downtown Denver. It is part of the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center campus. For people familiar with Denver it can best be approached by Colfax Avenue from the east or west, and Colorado Boulevard from the north or south. For more general directions from outside the Denver area or for parking, see the directions below.

From the North –

Come toward Denver from the north via Interstate 25 (I-25) heading south. Before getting to Denver, take I-70 east to Colorado Boulevard. Get off I-70 on the Colorado Boulevard exit and turn right heading south. Proceed south on Colorado Boulevard about 4 miles. You'll pass City Park and the Denver Zoo on the right. Go ½ mile past Colfax Avenue on your way south and you'll get to 10th Avenue. The main University campus will be on your left. You can either turn left onto 10th and pull into a paid parking structure on the right side that's attached to the Hospital, or proceed to 9th Avenue (a traffic light) and turn left to park on the street with parking meters. The University of Colorado Hospital will be on your left on the north side of 9th Avenue, right under the big overpass that connects buildings on the left and right sides of 9th Avenue.

From the South –

Come into Denver from the south via I-25 heading north. Exit 6th Avenue and turn right to head east. Proceed eastbound on 6th for about 3 miles until you come to Colorado Boulevard. Stay on the left side of 6th as you approach Colorado Boulevard to enter the left turn lane for Colorado Boulevard. Turn left onto Colorado Boulevard and proceed north for 3 or 4 blocks. The main University campus will be on your right. You can either turn right onto 9th Avenue (a traffic light) and park on the street with parking meters (UCH will be on your left on the north side of 9th under the big overpass that connects buildings on the left and right sides of 9th Avenue), or you can proceed north on Colorado Boulevard to 10th Avenue and then turn right to park in a paid parking structure that's attached to the University of Colorado Hospital.

From the East –

Head toward Denver from the east via I-70 westbound. Exit onto Colorado Boulevard and turn left so you are heading south. Proceed south on Colorado Blvd about 4 miles. You'll pass City Park and the Denver Zoo on the right. Go ½ mile past Colfax Avenue on your way south and you'll get to 10th Avenue. The main University campus will be on your left. You can either turn left onto 10th and pull into a paid parking structure on the right side that's attached to the Hospital, or proceed to 9th Avenue (a traffic light) and turn left to park on the street with parking meters. The University of Colorado Hospital will be on your left on the north side of 9th Avenue, right under the big overpass that connects buildings on the left and right sides of 9th Avenue.

From the West –

Head toward Denver from the west via I-70 heading east. Pass I-25 and proceed on I-70 to Colorado Boulevard. Get off I-70 on the Colorado Boulevard exit and turn right heading south. Proceed south on Colorado Boulevard about 4 miles. You'll pass City Park and the Denver Zoo on the right. Go ½ mile past Colfax Avenue on your way south and you'll get to 10th Avenue. The main University campus will be on your left. You can either turn left onto 10th and pull into a paid parking structure on the right side that's attached to the Hospital, or proceed to 9th Avenue (a traffic light) and turn left to park on the street with parking meters. The University of Colorado Hospital will be on your left on the north side of 9th Avenue, right under the big overpass that connects buildings on the left and right sides of 9th Avenue.

Parking –

There are paid parking meters on 9th Avenue with a two-hour limit. The 10th Avenue parking structure is attached to UCH but expensive if you are going to be there for more than a couple hours.
