

Quick Facts about the MD/MBA Health Program

How do I apply?

Please fill out the enclosed application form and return it to this address which is also indicated at the bottom of the application:

Please include the application fee of \$50.00. Checks may be made payable to the University of Colorado Denver.

You may submit your MCAT scores in lieu of the GMAT. Letters of recommendation are not required.

Once we receive your application, we will process it through the University system and mail our decision to your home address. You will receive a response within three weeks.

When should I apply to the MBA Health program?

You may apply in your third year of medical school.

Deadlines for priority admission are
June 1 Fall Semester
November 1 Spring Semester
April 1 Summer Semester

When are courses offered?

Most graduate business courses are offered during the evening hours. The fall and spring semesters are sixteen weeks long; evening courses typically meet either once a week (6:55-9:35 p.m.) or twice a week (4:00-5:15 p.m. or 5:30-6:45 p.m.). The summer semester is eight weeks long, and each class meets two evenings a week (M/W or T/R from 6-8:30 p.m.).

What is the tuition cost per credit?

As of Fall 2007, tuition for one graduate business credit for a resident is \$470. For a non-resident, the cost per credit is \$1,118. All graduate business courses are three-credits each, so tuition for one course is \$1,412, resident, and \$3,354, non-resident. Student fees are about \$200 per semester.

What GPA must I maintain through my program?

You are required to maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0, a B average, to remain in good standing and receive your degree.

How do I know which courses to take?
